Global Head of Credit Risk – Countries and Financial Institutions, Societe Generale

François Bloch has been Global Head of Credit Risk – Countries and Financial Institutions for Societe Generale since 2010. In this role, he is responsible for both country risk management as well as counterparty risk management on banks, insurance companies, funds and hedge funds for all the Group's entities. This is an extension of the responsibility he had held since March 2009 as Head of Credit Risk on Financial Institutions.

Before joining Societe Generale, François was Head of Corporate Strategy and Integration at Newedge Group. François had been with Newedge (formerly Fimat) since the beginning of his career, starting as a trainee at Fimat SNC, Paris, before spending a period as a futures & options broker on the CAC desk. He was then transferred to Fimat Frankfurt, where he headed the dealing room and the back-office before being named General Manager in 1995. Two years later, François left Germany to head the Central Risk Department at Fimat Banque in Paris. In July 2000, he joined Fimat New York, spending eighteen months as General Manager and then returned to Paris as Deputy CEO of Fimat International Banque S.A.

Born in 1967, François Bloch has a Bachelor's degree in Mathematics and Physics and a Master's degree in Statistics and Economics.
